## In case it's escaped anyone's attention, the 2024 general election is

right around the corner. Federal offices on the November 5 ballot are President/Vice-President and Alabama's seven US House of Representative seats. State

offices include the Alabama Supreme Court Justice, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court (Place 1, 2, 3, and 4), Court of Criminal Appeals (Places 1, 2 and 3), Court of Civil Appeals (Places 1, 2 and 3), Public Service Commission President, State Board of Education (Districts 1, 3, 5 and 7), Circuit Court Judges (various seats) and District Court Judges (various seats). Various county offices will be on ballots to include Circuit Clerks. LWVAL Vote411 Manager, Judy Jones, reports that candidate surveys have been sent to all candidates in these state races. She says in her experience, candidates who are incumbents and/or unopposed are not

typically motivated to respond to survey invitations but that the information will still be beneficial to voters. LWVAL expects to publish Alabama information on Vote411 Thursday September 12. LWVGB plans to activate Vote411 for greater Birmingham candidate races before the end of September. Greater Birmingham Ministries plans to publish a voter guide during October.
